**CAMP TURKEY IS A ‘FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVE’ CAMP PROGRAM FOR BOY SCOUTS
YOUTH REGISTRATION IS LIMITED TO THE FIRST 290 SCOUTS TO SIGN UP**

Camp Turkey registration starts on September 10, 2018. The cost to attend Winter Camp is \$130.00 due in full at time of registration. Only Scouts paid in full will be able to sign up for Merit Badge Courses!

After October 23rd, the registration fee is \$150.00, ONLY if slots are available.

Troop Registration information and forms will be available no later than August 15th. Troops should register as a group instead of individual registrations. Individual registration forms will be available for Scouts not attending with their Troop.

Winter Camp Staff includes over 75 Scout Leaders who serve as Merit Badge Councilors, shooting sports staff, cooking staff and Campsite Host for the Troops attending. Adult leaders wanting to attend Winter Camp are encouraged to serve on staff, so contact the camp director to sign up for an adult staff position.

Non-staff Adult participation is limited. Troops attending without A SUFFICIENT NUMBER of adult staff members are limited to 2 non-staff adults. The fee for non-staff adults is \$40 to cover the cost of meals.

Class A uniforms are required to be worn to dinner in the Dining Hall every evening. Class B uniforms are the desired dress for the rest of time at camp.

Camp T-shirts are extra at a cost of \$12.00 each. Adult XXL & Adult XXXL are \$14.00 each. All t-shirts must be purchased at registration.

Camp check-in is at Kinsey Scout Reservation on Saturday, November 17th between 1:00pm and 4:00pm and check out is November 20th between 4:00pm and 5:00pm.

THERE ARE NO CAMP FEE REFUNDS DUE TO INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATIONS.

Scouts are encouraged to purchase the Merit Badge books before Camp starts. The Program Director will advise all Scoutmasters on which Merit Badges the Scout is assigned before camp begins. Snacks and other items will be available at the Camp Trading Post for purchase. ALL SCOUTS will need to bring their Scout book, writing instruments, and notebooks for classes, and ALL personal camping equipment such as tents, sleeping bags, water containers, clothes, mosquito repellent, etc. It is the responsibility of each camper to have, use properly, and secure all their belongings. Norwela Council and the camp staff are not responsible for any loss or damage to personal property.

The Camp Program Director will assign ALL Scout participant classes. (Because the camp is limited, so is the number of participants per merit badge or Trail to First Class.)

VERY IMPORTANT! Select Ten (10) Merit Badges you want by numbering them one (1) to ten (10) in the space provided by the appropriate merit badge name. PLEASE DO NOT SELECT MORE THAN FIVE (5) EAGLE REQUIRED MERIT BADGES. EVERY ATTEMPT WILL BE GIVEN TO ASSIGN AT LEAST TWO EAGLE REQUIRED MERIT BADGES. PLACE A (X) BY THE MERIT BADGES YOU **HAVE OR PLAN TO HAVE** BY THE TIME OF CAMP.

The Camp Program Director assigns ALL classes.

All merit badge assignments will be age-considered due to badge requirements and the skill levels needed. Every attempt will be given to assign at least two Eagle required merit badges. Eagle required merit badge program assignments will be considered and based on current rank to help Scouts of certain ranks needing Eagle badges to reach their next rank. Some merit badges will be offered at night.
