Fall 2017 Training Schedule

Course: Cub Scout Leader Specific Training

Description: is designed to provide position specific training for all Cub Scout Leader Positions. Cubmaster, Assistant Cubmaster, Committee Chairman, Committee Members, Den Leader, Assistant Den Leader. This training is designed to assist you in planning and executing the parts of your position in the Cub Scout Pack well. This Training includes Den Leader Position Specific, Cubmaster Position Specific, and Pack Committee Training.

Course: Boy Scout Leader Specific Training

Description: This course is designed to give the basics of what it means to be a Scoutmaster or an Assistant Scoutmaster in a Boy Scout Troop. This training covers topics like running a troop meeting, advancement, and utilizing the patrol method. This Training includes Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster Position Specific Training and Troop Committee Challenge.

Course: Youth Protection Specific Training (offered with Cub and Boy Scout Leader Specific Training)

Description: informs and instructs adults volunteers and parents about the BSA youth protection policies and procedures. This training is required for all registered adult leaders and is strongly encouraged to be taken by all parents in the unit. This training can be completed online by creating an account at my.scouting.org or can be taken face to face before or after any of the Leader Specific Series of trainings

Course: Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO)

Description: This basic out-door skills program is designed for Cub Scout Leaders who want to plan and carry out an entry-level outdoor experience for the Cub Scout Pack. This is required for adults giving leadership on a Pack overnighiter. This course will give leaders the opportunity to get some ideas about to make a Pack overnighiter a great event that keeps the youth engaged. Come prepared for the weather and to learn new skills.

Course: Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS)

Description: This outdoor program is designed to provide basic outdoor skills essential to the Boy Scout program. This course is required training for Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, and Venturing Advisors who wish to be considered a trained leader. It is recommended for Webelos leaders and other adults who will be camping with youth. You will be camping and need to bring necessary gear. Come prepared for any kind of weather and having eaten dinner.

Course: Outdoor Webelos Leader Training (OWL)

Description: This is for all Webelos leaders. This training course covers the skills & resources needed to teach the outdoor activity badges and helps to provide good & safe outdoor experiences. Completion of this training is required before a Webelos den can go on a campout. You will be camping and need to bring necessary gear. Come prepared for any kind of weather and having eaten your dinner. Outdoor Webelos Leader Training is taught as a part of Introduction To Outdoor Leader Skills. Those wishing to be certified as trained in Outdoor Webelos Leader Training will need to stay after the end of Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills to cover the Cub Scout specific portion of this training.

Pre-registration is required for all courses.
