CAMP TURKEY YOUTH INFORMATION & REGISTRATION FORM

CAMP TURKEY IS A 'FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVE' CAMP PROGRAM FOR BOY SCOUT YOUTH.

CAMP TURKEY REGISTRATION FOR NORWELA COUNCIL YOUTH IS AT 9:00AM ON SEPTEMBER 12, 2009 AT THE SCOUT SERVICE CENTER ON BEVERLY STREET IN SHREVEPORT, LA. THE COST TO ATTEND WINTER CAMP IS \$100.00 DUE IN FULL AT REGISTRATION WITH A COMPLETED REGISTRATION FORM AND CURRENT MEDICAL FORM. OPEN REGISTRATION FOR ALL COUNCILS STARTS ON SEPTEMBER 19, 2009 AT THE COUNCIL SERVICE CENTER. LATE REGISTRATION FEE IS \$120.00 (AFTER OCTOBER 2) ON AN IF SLOTS ARE AVAILABLE BASIS ONLY.

CLASS A UNIFORMS ARE REQUIRED TO BE WORN TO DINNER IN THE DINNING HALL EVERY EVENING. CLASS B UNIFORMS ARE THE DESIRED DRESS FOR THE REST OF TIME AT CAMP.

CAMP T-SHIRTS ARE EXTRA AT A COST OF \$12.00 EACH. ADULT XXL & ADULT XXXL ARE \$14.00 EACH. ALL T-SHIRTS MUST BE PURCHASED AT REGISTRATION.

Some merit badge programs require project kits or program supplies. It is the responsibility of each Scout to have enough personal money to purchase these items as needed at camp. Parents, it is your responsibility to send your Scout to camp with enough money for this purpose. \$25.00 is a suggested amount.

CAMP CHECK IN IS AT GARLAND SCOUT RANCH, SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 21ST BETWEEN 1:00PM AND 4:00PM.

THERE ARE NO CAMP FEE REFUNDS DUE TO INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATIONS.

No registration forms will be accepted at the Council Service Center before September 12, 2009. No faxed registration forms will be accepted because payment is due with the registration form.

Merit badge books, craft materials, and snacks will be available at the Camp Trading Post for purchase. ALL SCOUTS will need to bring their scout book, writing instruments, and notebooks for classes. All personal camping equipment such as tents, sleeping bags, water containers, clothes, mosquito repellent, etc. is the responsibility of each camper to have, use properly, and secure. Norwela Council and the camp staff are not responsible for any loss or damage to personal property.

THE CAMP PROGRAM DIRECTOR WILL ASSIGN ALL SCOUT PARTICIPANT CLASSES. (BECAUSE THE CAMP IS LIMITED, SO IS THE NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS PER MERIT BADGE OR TRAIL TO FRST CLASS.)
