This 10-hour course is being taught by the Caddo Parish Sheriffs Department. The course is open to those in Scouting and siblings 10 years and older including adults. If you have someone who wants to take the course and is not a Scout, they will need to complete a Youth or Adult application and join a Scout unit.

There will be a 35-person enrollment limit for this course.

If Scouts choose to camp overnight on Friday, unless they are camping with their Boy Scout Troop, they will be assigned a campsite. Cub Scouts will have to have an adult camp with them.

Eat before you come on Friday night or bring a sack lunch.

Breakfast, snack and lunch on Saturday will be provided.

If any Scouts choose to cook their own meals, they will need to provide their own food.
