QUARTERMASTER: The tent on order should be here tomorrow. All supplies that were authorized have been purchased. Scoutmaster also donated 5 5-gal water containers & 5 ice chests for each patrol.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Deadline to pay for flag/badge (\$7) is June 1. Only 9 have paid so far.

Jill noted that the \$25 that was voted to be put into the Scoutmaster's petty cash fund had not been done. Diane said she would see to that. Avail cash was \$766.78. Less than \$50 is outstanding for 2008 dues. See official report for more details.

OUTINGS: We still need an additional leader for Thurs-Sat. at Garland summer camp. Ryan will be there the entire week. Adopt-A-Road scheduled for 6/7 at 2:00. A Work day at the church is scheduled for 6/13.
